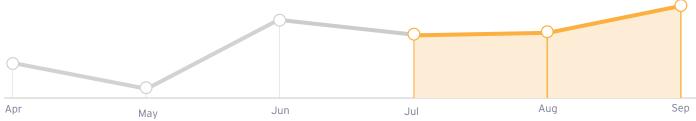

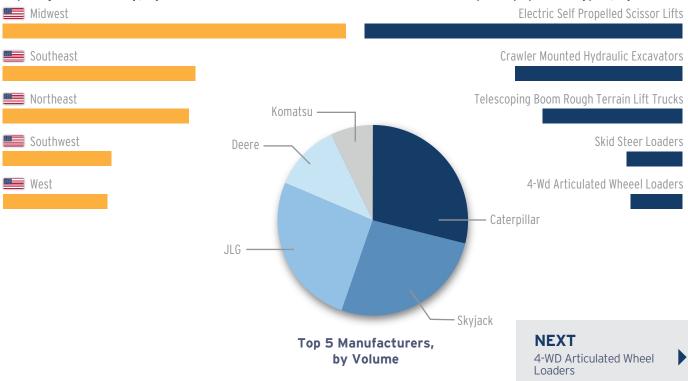
### SUMMARY

After a brief dip in July, prices for the most popular 5 subtypes continued on a steady rise, with September's increase driven mainly by Crawler Mounted Excavators and 4-Wd Articulated Wheel Loaders. The Midwest took over a large part of the market share, with more than double the share of the next largest region, the Southeast. Similarly, Electric Self Propelled Scissor Lifts made huge gains, increasing its dominance over the rest of the field.

This analysis was conducted using data from the ValueTrend Engine<sup>™</sup>, the EquipmentWatch valuation platform. All currency shown is in U.S. Dollars. Regions were selected based upon the Bureau of Economic Analysis standards and the 4-Region Canadian model.

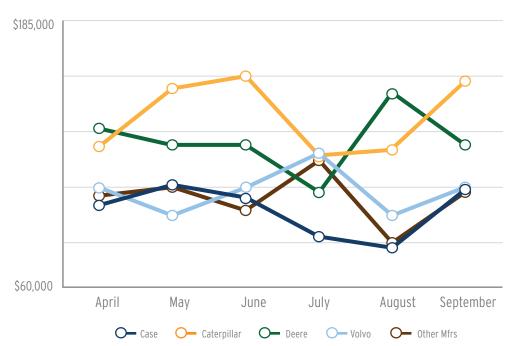

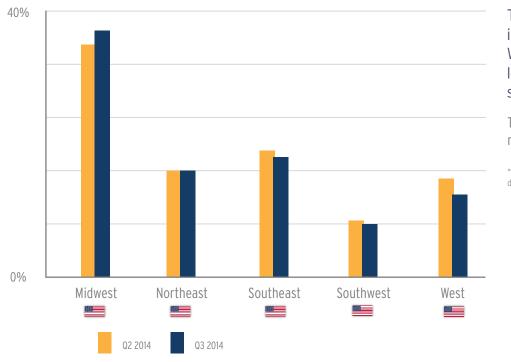
### 4-WD ARTICULATED WHEEL LOADERS AVERAGE UNIT ASKING PRICE, BY MONTH

Caterpillar lost their price premium in the 4-WD Articulated Wheel Loader market in July, but was able to regain it in September.

Case also dropped below the rest of the field before rebounding in September.

### 4-WD ARTICULATED WHEEL LOADERS PERCENT MARKET SHARE, TOP 5 REGIONS



The most substantial movement in the market took place in the West and Southwest, each losing about 1% of the market share.

The Midwest made gains in this market, along with others.

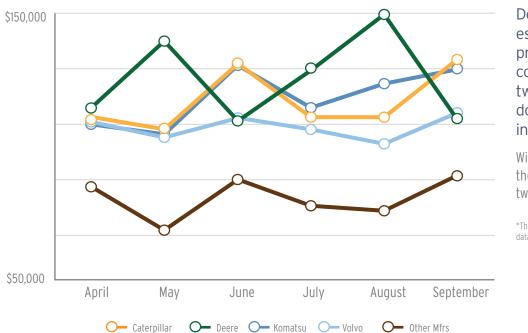

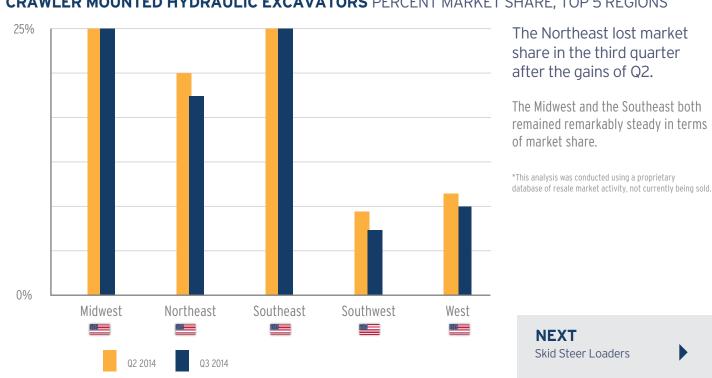

### **CRAWLER MOUNTED HYDRAULIC EXCAVATORS** AVERAGE UNIT ASKING PRICE, BY MONTH

Deere came close to establishing a price premium in the market a couple times over the last two guarters, but came back down to the rest of the pack in September.

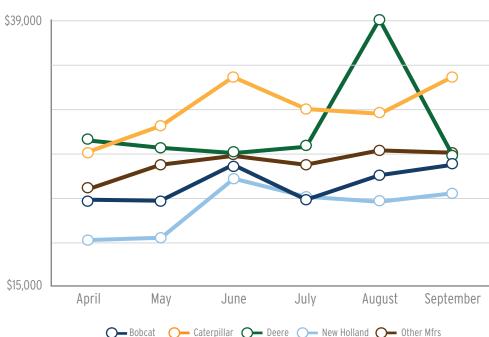
With Deere's fall, Caterpillar rose to the top for the second time in the past two guarters in September.

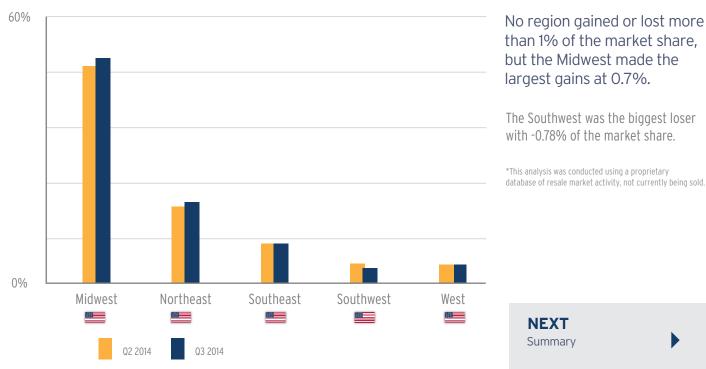
SKID STEER LOADERS AVERAGE UNIT ASKING PRICE, BY MONTH

The massive surge in August displayed by Deere appears to have been just an anomaly, as they dropped well below Caterpillar the very next month.

Deere's august total notwithstanding, Caterpillar led the pack for most of the last six months.
